Christopher Pickering Lodge



Christopher Pickering Lodge lies at the heart of the Summergroves ‘village’ provided by Pickering and Ferens Homes to the south of Hessle High Road in West Hull.

It was the first of the sheltered schemes to be completed, in 1991, and some of the residents have lived there since it was opened.

The Lodge, as it is known, comprises 36 sheltered flats, including one flat suitable for use by disabled persons, a large communal area, a laundry room and guest room. The Lodge prides itself on the large number of activities and events that are provided for residents. For example, there is a gym area with a wide range of exercise equipment, a library, jig-saw library and billiard table.

Christopher Pickering Lodge is also the meeting place and event venue for many community groups based in the surrounding area. The Scheme Manager lives in nearby Bush Close and provides a point of contact and help and reassurance to residents as and when they require it.

Our Summergroves village is made up of 100 bungalows, 26 elderly persons’ flats, two houses and a Pop-In centre in Wheatfield Close, all set in pleasant landscaped surroundings.

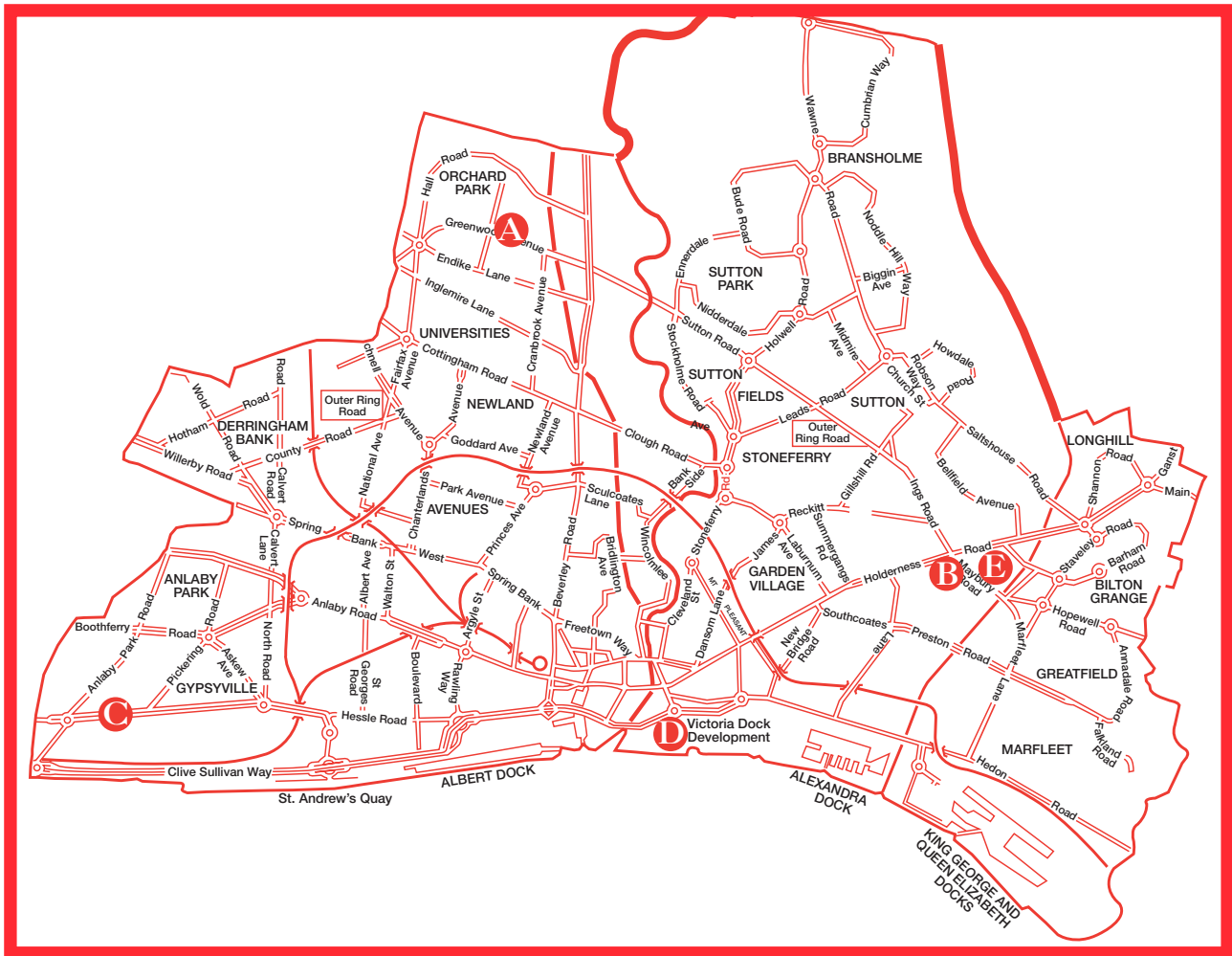
